WHEREAS, Graduate students are particularly susceptible the power differential with their advisors, particularly when it comes to research; and

WHEREAS, Purdue University currently has no authorship standard for scholarly works; and

WHEREAS, Since 2019, nine authorship conflicts were resolved by the Purdue Research Integrity Officer (RIO), Dr. Jamie Mohler; and

WHEREAS, A clear authorship standard would better inform the Purdue research community of best practices surrounding authorship, and could help prevent potential conflicts; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Mohler, as RIO, has proposed an authorship standard on scholarly works; and

WHEREAS, The Purdue University Senate will be holding a vote to endorse said standard on November 21, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That PGSG endorses the adoption of this authorship standard for scholarly works.
